This magical city lies in South Africa, one of the 57 countries of Africa.

South Africa is a vibrant and welcoming country with much to offer visitors. From its stunning natural beauty to its rich cultural heritage, South Africa and Cape Town is a destination that should be on everyone's travel list.

Passport, visa and health requirements can vary according to your country of citizenship.

- Please note that visitors who wish to travel to South Africa must have a passport that is valid for at least 30 days after their intended return date from South Africa.
- It's important to note that passport holders must have at least 1 completely unused visa page for entry or departure endorsements by South African Immigration Service in their passport.
- Government regulations prohibit airlines from boarding travellers without the required blank visa pages, even if you hold a valid ticket and a valid passport.
- That requirement for a blank page does not include the page reserved for Observations, Amendments or Endorsements.

Ah, Cape Town, where the weather is like a box of chocolates – you never know what you're gonna get

Cape Town's weather is a mix of Mediterranean summers and cool, wet winters.

The best time to visit depends on your interests:

- January March: Ideal for beaches and warm weather.
- April June: Crisp, clear days perfect for hiking.
- July September: Whale-watching season!
- October December: Great for exploring, but peak tourist season.

The Western Cape is all about winter rain and winds that could make Mary Poppins blush. Plus, the weather can be different on either side of Table Mountain.

Pack your bags for all seasons cause you might need sunscreen one minute and a scarf the next.

Pro-tip: If Lion's Head has a mini cloud hanging over it, grab that umbrella and jacket - rain's coming your way.

From February to May, we soak up the warm rays and enjoy the sweet life.

Then, winter sneaks in with rainy days during June to August.

But no worries, September to November is still primo time to explore this beautiful city.

Just watch out for December and January when the crowds flock to Cape Town, and prices shoot up like a rocket.

South African Standard Time (SAST) is the <u>time</u> <u>zone</u> used by all of <u>South Africa</u> as well as <u>Eswatini</u> and <u>Lesotho</u>.

The zone is two hours ahead of <u>UTC (UTC+02:00</u>) and is the same as <u>Central Africa Time</u>. <u>Daylight</u> <u>saving time</u> is not observed in either time zone.

Note: January to March is the best time for beaches and sunny weather. Late April to early June has crisp and clear days, perfect for a hiking trip.

When preparing for your Cape Town adventure, ensure you pack a variety of items. It's crucial to be ready for whatever Mother Nature has in store for you!

- Attire:
 - Cape Town (and South Africa in general) has a relaxed dress code compared to North America and Europe. Most top restaurants in Cape Town don't require formal attire; a jacket (but no tie) is typically sufficient. Opt for a casually elegant look.
 - Cape Town is known for its laid-back atmosphere. You'll see people in cafes dressed in anything from business attire to casual wear like sundresses or yoga pants.
- Jewelry:
 - It's advisable not to wear expensive jewelry or clothing while strolling around Cape Town. This precaution can help you avoid unwanted attention.





Always have a light sweater or jacket on hand for a sudden change in weather.

Foreigners can easily rent a car in South Africa.

- Renters must have a valid driver's license.
- Be 18 years old.
- They must also have had their license for at least one year.
- You will need an International Driver's Permit (IDP)
- In addition, you'll have to show your passport and provide a valid credit card for the rental car purchase and hold a charge.

You must always have your driver's license on you while driving in South Africa or Cape Town.
