Weather During Travel Dates (April – May 2025)

During this period, South Africa enjoys mild to pleasant autumn weather, with comfortable temperatures across the regions. Here's a general overview:

- **Cape Town and the Western Cape:**
 - Temperatures: Around 15°C to 20°C during the day, with cooler evenings (10°C to 15°C).
 - Weather: April and May are part of the autumn season, bringing mild temperatures and some rainfall. April tends to be drier, but occasional showers are possible, especially in Cape Town.
- **Garden Route (Knysna, Plettenberg Bay, Oudtshoorn):**
 - Temperatures: Daytime highs of around 18°C to 23°C, with cooler evenings.
 - Weather: The weather here is typically mild, though some coastal areas may be a bit cooler and wetter, especially near Tsitsikamma. Expect pleasant conditions for exploring the outdoors.
- **Safari Areas :**
 - Temperatures: Days can reach 20°C to 25°C, and nights may dip to 5°C to 10°C.
 - Weather: The safari areas in the Western Cape are dry and mild, with sunny days and cooler evenings. Ideal for game drives as the wildlife is easier to spot during these conditions.

Packing Tips:

- Layers: Due to the varying temperatures, it's best to pack layers—light clothing for the daytime and warmer options for evenings.
- Rain Gear: A light waterproof jacket or umbrella for occasional showers in Cape Town or the Garden Route could be useful.

Cape Town City Pass

This pass provides access to many attractions and can help skip lines for places like the Table Mountain Cableway and Two Oceans Aquarium.

Use the hop-on, hop-off sightseeing bus for easy access to all major attractions. The bus is comfortable and well-equipped, making it ideal for tourists. Time Considerations: The hop-on, hop-off bus typically runs from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, so be mindful of the time when visiting attractions to ensure you don't miss out.

I'd recommend the 3-Day Pass. This would allow enough time to cover the major highlights and still leave room for some leisure days. **The Cape Town City Pass is valid for 3 consecutive days from the first use.**

Day 2 – Cape Town Exploration



Use your Cape Town City Pass

- Explore the V&A Waterfront or take a cruise to Robben Island.

Day 6-7 – Wine day

- Head to Stellenbosch or Paternoster for wine tasting and picturesque vineyard experiences.


Day 15-16 – Return to Cape Town

● 5 Day Garden Route Tour

Day 1

Depart Cape Town at 6am and head up to Oudtshoorn in the Little Karoo semi desert area, which also is the ostrich capital of the World. This drive follows the world-famous Route 62 which is the longest wine route in the world! We'll visit the Cango Caves for a tour through this magnificent cave system and also visit an ostrich farm for a closer look at this enormous bird. Tonight, we'll stay in Oudtshoorn and have a delicious local dish for dinner.

Leaving Oudtshoorn we'll cross the mountain range to the coast and the gorgeous Garden Route. Here we will visit the Knysna Heads, Waterfront, markets and explore thoroughly. After Knysna we pass through Plettenberg Bay

Day 3:

The magnificent Tsitsikamma National Park awaits us this morning. Thundering waves, thick forest, plentiful birdlife and otters, this National Park has it all! Walk the coastal route to the hanging bridge over Storms River Mouth and experience what makes this the most scenic park in South Africa. From here we'll head onto the Addo elephant National Park and your opportunity to spot huge elephant herds, various antelope species, dung beetles galore and more. For those whom are not interested in Addo, we drive through Jeffrey's Bay – the surfing Capital of South Africa! Shopping, surfing, sun & beautiful white beaches will keep you occupied until sunset falls upon this beautiful town! Tonight, we overnight in Jeffrey's Bay.

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

Included Highlights: Game drive in your tour vehicle through Addo Elephant National Park. Safari Entrance to Tsitsikamma National Park

Optional Activities: Walk to scenic hanging bridge over Storms River mouth

Overnight: Jeffrey's Bay

Day 4:

From the Eastern Cape, we head back towards the Garden Route and to the World's highest Bungy Bridge at Bloukrans (plenty of time to jump for those thrill seekers). This 216-m high bungy is a true marvel to behold, even for those that have a fear of heights!

Our journey leads us to a Game Lodge where we will also overnight in the luxury accommodation (Chalets or Lodge room). We will do a late afternoon safari drive where we will have the opportunity to view rhino, lion, buffalo, cheetah, and many varieties of antelope species. A sumptuous and varied dinner is served at the lodge and is yet another highlight!


